

# RED ROCK TIME LINE

**2010 - 2019**

*To build the transit ridership base in the corridor, the Commission will work to expand bus service and provide additional Park & Ride facilities*

**2000**

*The Red Rock Corridor Commission completed a Phase One Commuter Rail Feasibility Study.*

**2007**

*The Red Rock Corridor Commission completed the Alternative Analysis (AA) which recommends building the ridership base by expanding bus service and adding Park & Ride facilities as the first steps towards commuter rail.*

**2010 - 2011**

*The Red Rock Corridor Commission conducts a station area and site study for building transit stations including St. Paul (Lower Afton Road), Newport, Cottage Grove and Hastings.*

**2012 - 2013**

*The Red Rock Corridor Commission will conduct an advanced Alternative Analysis to re-visit all cost allocations and refine the ridership projections.*

**2014 - 2016**

*Final design and engineering for the commuter rail line will be completed.*

**2015**

*The Red Rock Corridor Commission finalizes commuter rail designs.*

**2016 - 2018**

*Red Rock Corridor commuter rail construction begins.*

**2019**

*Red Rock commuter rail begins service to St. Paul.*

**2022**

*Red Rock commuter rail service extends to Minneapolis.*

*The Commission will coordinate commuter rail planning and construction with efforts to build high-speed rail from Twin Cities to Chicago along the same corridor **2010-2016***
